Dear Findlay City Schools Community:

As you may be aware, Findlay City Schools is in the process of restructuring the district due to the closure of Lincoln Elementary and the repurposing of Jacobs Primary to serve as our preschool building. We have analyzed the current school boundaries and enrollment patterns when conducting the restructuring process. We have taken many factors into account such as the following: enrollment at each school based on current boundaries, class size targets, functional capacity for each school, the proximity of the school to students residence (transportation), keeping siblings together when possible. The effort of restructuring the district will aid in the efforts to balance school site populations and serve students in the most equitable and educationally sound manner.

Please note that if your student is in a special education unit you will be notified of any changes. ESL services will remain at Whittier, Wilson Vance, and Glenwood.

On behalf of the district administration, we thank you for your continued support and understanding as we move forward with this process. Open houses are being planned for families to be able to tour the schools. We are committed to making this transition as smooth as possible for students and families.
